

DIRECTIONS:

Print out printable, and cut out fraction pieces.

Grab at least 4 rhombuses and 4 trapezoids from your pattern blocks.

Place fraction cards face up. Player one may choose whatever model they want. They will then cover up whatever fraction represents the model. Player two then has his turn and proceeds to do the same.

The game ends when someone has three in a row or all the spaces are covered up.

Printable, pattern blocks,

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
